## **Building Reactivation Checklist**

Ready to re-open your vacant building after temporarily closing due to circumstances that required you to halt services? Since your building has

been closed for some period of time, it may have been exposed to perils such as vandalism and weather-related damages that went unnoticed. Opening a facility that has been closed for any period of time should be done carefully. You should check for damages that may have been caused while the building was vacant. Additionally, for the safety of your staff and patrons, you should ensure your building and equipment are up to safety codes prior to offering services again. Use this checklist to help you properly reopen your building.

Are doors and windows in good working condition?			
Is interior lighting in good working condition?			
If present, is security alarm in good working order?

<b>Fire Safety</b> (Note: You might consider having a licensed contractor inspect smoke and alarm systems prior to reopening the building)			
Is there a fire safety plan in place?			
Are there regular fire drills in place?			
Are fire alarm & smoke detection systems in good working condition?			
Are sprinkler systems in good working condition?			
Are fire hydrants in good working condition and accessible?			
Are there fire extinguishers throughout the facility?			
<b>Power</b> (Note: You might consider having have a licensed contractor inspect and test the sprinkler system(s) prior to reopening the building)			
Has all non-essential power been reconnected?			
Has unneeded electrical equipment been turned back on?			
Health and Safety			
Has the staff been notified about any new policies in place?			
Is the building's heating system in good working condition?			
Is the building's air conditioning system in good working condition?			
Has the health and safety of the staff been addressed?			
Has the health and safety of visitors been addressed?			
Is there a method of recording visitors?			
Is the building clean and ready for reactivation?			

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
